

Irrevocable Waiver of Right of Disposition

If the person vested with the authority to determine final disposition fails to exercise that right within 72 hours of notification of the death of the decedent, they forfeit that right and it passes to the next person(s) described in the law.

I/we _____ bearing the relationship of _____ to the decedent, do hereby warrant and represent to the _____ Funeral Home that I/we have the authority to arrange for the disposition of the decedent under Indiana law, IC 25-15-9-18, *et al*, and that no one has an undisclosed equal or superior right of disposition.

I/we hereby irrevocably waive, relinquish, and give up my right to designate the manner, type, and selection of the final disposition of the decedent as well as the right to make arrangements for funeral services and/or other ceremonial arrangements for the decedent. I/we understand that I/we cannot change my mind and regain this right.

This waiver includes the irrevocable waiver and relinquishment of any right to seek the recovery, possession, relocation, or disinterment of the decedent's remains or cremated remains.

I/we hereby acknowledge that by signing this irrevocable waiver, the right of disposition for the decedent, in compliance with IC25-15-9-18; IC23-14-31-26; IC29-2-19-17, will transfer to the person(s) with legal authority as stipulated in the aforementioned Indiana statutes.

I/we furthermore understand that my/our waiver and relinquishment of the right of disposition does not entitle or allow for selection or appointment of the person(s) to control or direct said disposition of the decedent.

I/we hereby warrant and represent the truthfulness of these statements and that the funeral home may rely upon the statements made herein in good faith.

I/we agree to indemnify and hold harmless the funeral home, its owners, employees, and agents from any and all claims or causes of action arising from or related in any aspect to this waiver and the funeral home's reliance thereon.
